## **Lake Corriher Rules and Regulations**

Parking for Lake Corriber Wilderness Area is located at 955 Kimball Rd. The Park Office and Handicap access is located at 265 Tranquil Lake Dr.

- 1) Hours from 8 am- 5 pm from Oct 1st-Mar 31st. Hours 8 am- 8 pm Apr 1st- Sept 30th (Park Office gate closes and locks.)
- 2) Children 12 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult, 16 years of age or older
- 3) No Hunting Allowed
- 4) Fishing by permit Only
- 5) Boating by Rental Only (Minors must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older)
- 6) Use of Campsites by Rental Only
- 7) NO Motorized Vehicles/Boats Allowed
- 8) NO Smoking
- 9) NO Swimming
- 10) No Alcohol
- 11) Glass and other breakable objects are not permitted
- 12) No illegal drugs, or drug paraphernalia
- 13) All trash must be placed in proper receptacles
- 14) No refunds due to weather
- 15) Abusive or objective language (profanity), will not be permitted or tolerated
- 16) All pets must be on a leash at all times
- 17) No person shall play a radio so loud as to be an annoyance to other people or nearby residents.
- 18) Persons in the area should conduct themselves in such a way as to not disturb the peace and quiet of the area and surrounding neighborhood.
- 19) Caution should be used on trails due to rough terrain

\*Damage or defacement of any land or structure in the Lake Corriher Wilderness Area will incur a \$100 fine plus the cost of repairs

\*There will be a \$50 fine for being in the Wilderness Area after the posted hours. This penalty does not apply to scheduled or authorized events occurring after hours. All vehicles parked after hours must display a parking pass. Unauthorized vehicles will be towed at owners expense.

## **Fishing Guidelines**

- 1) All NC State Wildlife Fishing Regulations apply.
- 2) Fish Size Limit and Bag limit will now fall under State Regulations.
- 3) There will be a limit of <u>Three</u> fishing poles per person.
- 4) NC State Fishing License Required.

\*There will be a \$50 fine for fishing without a permit.

\*There will be a \$150 fine for failure to adhere to the bag limit regulations above.
