**North Carolina's law on stopping for a school bus**

All traffic must stop for a stopped bus, unless it is on a road of four or more lanes with a median or center turning lane. In those instances, oncoming traffic does not have to stop because children will not be crossing the road to reach the bus. Traffic following a bus must always stop with the bus. If in doubt, always stop for a stopped bus.

- Two-lane road**  
All traffic from both directions must stop.
- Two-lane road with a center turning lane**  
All traffic from both directions must stop.
- Four-lane road without a median separation**  
All traffic from both directions must stop.
- Divided highway of four lanes or more with a median separation**  
Only traffic following the school bus must stop.
- Road of four lanes or more with a center turning lane**  
Only traffic following the school bus must stop.

## PUBLIC WORKS COLLECTIONS

**PLEASE NOTE:** Leaf collection utilizing the leaf machine has ended. Any leaves needing picked up must now be bagged and placed at the curb.

- Household garbage is picked up on Mondays, by a contractor, on a weekly basis.
- Leaves should be bagged and placed at the curb for pick-up. Please do not place on sidewalks.
- Brush/Chipping collection is picked up on Wednesdays/Thursdays on a weekly basis and is weather permitting. Collection will occur as soon as possible after weather events. Brush must be stacked in the same direction. Anything over approximately 8 inches in diameter will NOT be collected. When using contractor services, contractors are responsible for the removal of all brush/trees/debris.
- On holidays, garbage should be put out at regular times unless otherwise notified. Notifications will be posted on the Towns Website and Facebook page regarding any changes in schedule.

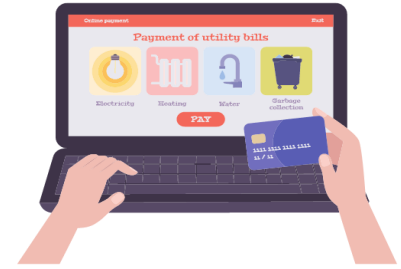
